Report on 150th Anniversary Celebration – Hale said that the next meeting will be Tuesday, April 12th.

Report on Operations – A written report was submitted.

Hearing of Citizens and Taxpayers – Attending the meeting on behalf of the Little League were Kathryn Doubet, Bob Burchill, Nick Vella and Scott Spaid. They wanted to talk with Council about the poor condition of the fields on Lura Road, replacing the dugouts at the Stein fields and who was responsible for the upkeep of the areas.

The Council said that the Lura Road Rec Area had a Master Site Plan completed a number of years ago with grant funding. After the Master Site Plan was completed there were various projects that had to be done to the area. The next phase, which is currently under way, is the installation of the restrooms/concession stand/storage building. The grant funding has been approved and now we are in the final design phase of the project.

The Council said that the Borough and Cambridge Township have each contributed \$5,000 to the Recreation Fund each year. Those funds pay for the portable toilets each year and the remaining funds will be used for the construction of the building. The Borough does all of the mowing each year.

The Little League is going to replace the dugouts at Stein field and would like help with some of the cost for the materials.

They would like drainage to be installed at the Lura Road fields to help with the standing water.

In the future they would like to see more fields at the Lura Road Rec Area.

Council said if the Little League was to put together a "wish list" of projects they have for the Stein fields or Lura Road fields, they would be willing to review the list and see what projects the Borough could fund.


Adjournment
