1. Ryan Shaffer – Eagle Scout Project

Ryan presented his proposal to the Borough Council for his Eagle Scout project which is to make five flower boxes to be placed in the public parking lot behind the old Dairy Mart property. The flower boxes will be similar to the ones already located in the downtown area. He obtained two estimates, one from Home Depot and one from Lowe's. The Home Depot estimate was the least expensive at \$375.82. He will also check with Hobb's to get an estimate. He said that if the Council approves his project he will then submit it to the Scout Council for approval. If the project is approved he would like to have it completed by early to mid July.

2. Little Gridders

Heather Butler and Mike Hauf presented Council with the short term and long term projects that the Little Gridders have obtained quotes for. The short term project would be to refurbish the existing concession stand at a cost of \$464.96 and the long term projects would include crowning the two football fields at a cost of \$38,329 and installing french drains at a cost of \$2,870.

Viglione showed them the plans for the recreation area where the restroom/concession stand/storage building will be once it is completed. Viglione said that they should schedule a time to meet and go over the project.
