

**Minutes – March 16, 2015**

A regular meeting was held by the Borough of Cambridge Springs Council on Monday, March 16, 2015, at 161 Carringer Street. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Randy Gorske at 7:00 p.m. The following members were present: Dan Viglione, Sam English, John Lane, Delores Hale, Larry Morrow and Tom Brown. **Committee Reports**

- 1. Administration & Finance** – Randy Gorske submitted a written report
- 2. Police Committee** – Larry Morrow reported on the meeting
- 3. Land Use & General Safety** – Dan Viglione submitted a written report

The Borough received a quote from Lubiniecki Welding for a Ventrac sidewalk plow/mower.

Pude said there were a couple of items that would not be necessary such as the outside mirrors and the directional signal/flasher.

English had a question on the quote where it was listed a Kubota. Pude said under the specifications for the tractor it has listed the four different engines available, Vanguard, Kawasaki and two different Kubota engines.

Brown asked if the snow blower would be a consideration if it is 52". English said we could still consider getting it because it can be used.

Morrow asked about the deep snow kit. Pude said that is an optional kit for the auger.

Gorske said the quote doesn't show where they are approved for the State Contract pricing.

Pude was instructed to get the information on the questions that were raised and a recommendation from John Dine.

**Report on Operations** - Manager/Secretary Pude submitted a written report.

**Report on 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration** – Delores Hale said the committee discussed getting approval from the Borough to have a winter carnival at the Carnival Grounds. Dave Matejczyk has agreed to organize a waffle ball tournament. The Committee will have a booth at this year’s Carnival to sell commemorative items and hand out promotional brochures. She also said they discussed having the historical mural mounted so that it could be easily relocated if necessary.

**Hearing of Citizens and Taxpayers** – Heather Wilmoth asked about petitioning the Council to consider allowing chickens in the Borough. Gorske said that she wouldn’t need to petition the Council, but the ordinance regulating animals would need to be changed. He suggested to Wilmoth to provide some information on regulations to the Land Use and General Safety Committee. The Committee would review it and present their findings to the entire Council.

**Unfinished Business**

**1. Lord Corporation Expansion**

Darrell Weaver updated the Borough Council on the expansion project. He said that the expansion has reached substantial completion. They received their inspection for the occupancy permit. The press should be delivered in June and operational in September. The Fire Department will be taking a tour on April 9<sup>th</sup>. Council said they would like to take a tour after the press has been installed. It was decided that the Council would schedule a tour in either August or September.


**Adjournment**
