New & Other Business

1. DEP Meeting – Water Well Drilling Discussion

Pude provided a written report on the November 18th meeting with members of the DEP concerning the possibility of drilling water wells.

Pude said the Borough would need to provide three different locations for test wells. Those locations would need to meet specific criteria to be considered. The Borough would also be required to pay for any new driveways or roads to the location for the test wells. Also, the Borough would be required to pay for the water quality/quantity testing and any permits that would be required. The DEP said the Borough would need a well that would produce at least 200 gallons of water per minute and that we should have two usable wells.

Pude said she spoke with the Engineers after the conference call and they said if we were to drill wells, we would need to either build a pumping station/treatment plant or run a water line to the existing treatment plant. Either option would be an expense. They suggested installing a carbon filtration system that would eliminate the musty smelling water we have had the last two summers.

Pude will ask the Engineers to provide some information on the cost to drill, maintain and treat well water versus installing the carbon filtration system.

Hale thanked L. J. Lydic, Brian Krise and Frank Reichart for taking down the military banners and putting up the Christmas decorations


Adjournment
