1. USG Water/Suez – Proposal for Repairs to Filters @ Water Plant

Pude said that the tube settlers in the two filters at the water treatment plant need to be replaced. USG Water did an inspection and provided a proposal to replace those at a cost of \$331,242.00. Also, while the filters are drained, USG Water will perform the Year Ten maintenance on each of the filters. That maintenance consists of removing the filter media, chemically cleaning the filters and touching up any of the epoxy coating on the interiors and exteriors of the filters. Then the new tube settlers will be installed.


