Recreation Areas

Angie Mumford said for the Stine Fields they would like to have supplies available for Cambridge Cares Day to repair the batting cage, paint the concession stand, shed & dugouts as well as a load of dura edge to mix with the existing dirt on the one field. She is working on getting quotes for these items. Angie also said they need some fill dirt for low lying areas between the fields.

Cambridge Township said they may have some fill dirt, if so, they can also have it delivered to the fields.

Carl Franz said the Little Gridders need a new storage shed/concession stand he will get some quotes.

Matt Livermore said the Little League needs a new field drag, a new batting cage and necessary equipment to install the new scoreboard. Their estimated cost for the three items is \$5,000.


