

MINUTES – March 21, 2022

Borough of Cambridge Springs

A regular meeting was held by the Cambridge Springs Borough Council on Monday, March 21, 2022, at 161 Carringer Street. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Randy Gorske at 7:00 p.m. The following members were present: Jennifer Howell, Marci Dickson, Jeremy Ball, Larry Morrow and Brian Harmon. Also present were Cambridge Township Supervisors Charlie Bauer and Bernie Blystone, Township Secretary Debra Merritt, Manager/Secretary Sandy Pude and Police Chief Acker. Delores Hale was absent

Discussion with Cambridge Township Supervisors – Recreation Area

Pude provided a list of items requested by the Little League, Cambridge Crush and Little Gridders.

Josh Snow from Little League said they will be working on removing the electric from the old concession stand at the Brink Drive fields and moving it to the new concession stand. Once that is done, the Borough will tear down the old concession stand. Also, they have contacted the company that installed the baseball fields to have them reconditioned at an approximate cost of \$500 per field.

Cambridge Crush submitted cost estimates for a bull pen, dirt for the fields and behind the fencing all of which total approximately \$1,320. They would also like to have port-a-potties rented for the summer at a cost of \$1,040.

Little Gridders would like to add an announcers stand over the concession stand with a small storage room. No cost estimates were submitted.

The Township Supervisors will discuss the estimates that were submitted at their next meeting in April.
