This grant if awarded requires matching funds of \$70,000 and we would be able to purchase a play structure, the ground covering below and the new parking area.

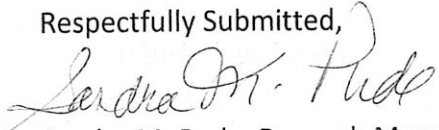
Adjournment
