**Hearing of Citizens and Taxpayers**

Mary Ann Mook from 420 South Main Street said she has noticed someone walking their dog in Marcy Park on more than one occasion even though there are signs in place.

Chief Acker spoke with the Council regarding the quotes that were received for the installation of cameras in the area around Marcy Park, the Carnival Grounds as well as the Borough Office/Police Department.

The estimate from Canadohta Security for the Borough Office is \$4,420 and \$4,765 to install cameras at the Carnival Grounds and also Marcy Park.

The Chief said with the recent stolen vehicle he had to find businesses in the area that have security cameras and review their tapes. He would like to have the two cameras in Marcy Park installed so that there will be views south and north in the business district.

The Chief said the cameras at the Borough Office/Police Department would include both entrances, the garage, the patrol room, Council room and Borough Office lobby. The camera in the interview room would also include audio recording.

Council agreed that the security cameras should be installed at Marcy Park, the Carnival Grounds and at the Borough Office/Police Department.

Pude will contact Canadohta Security for the installation.

**1. Gary Brickett – Grant Street - Stormwater**

Mr. Brickett did not attend the meeting. Pude said she had previously spoke with him about the stormwater runoff. Pude said the Borough was waiting until the Main Street Bridge project was completed because Grant Street was the detour for that project. Now that the detour is no longer in place, the Borough Streets will do the project this year.

**2. Resolution #623-2022 – Grant Application**

A motion was made by Morrow to adopt Resolution #623-2022 which authorized the Mayor and Borough Manager to sign documents for the \$189,805 grant application for the replacement of the underdrains in the filter at the Water Treatment Plant. 
**Adjournment**
