

MINUTES – September 8 2022
Borough of Cambridge Springs

A special meeting was held by the Cambridge Springs Borough Council on Thursday, September 8, 2022, at 161 Carringer Street. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Randy Gorske at 7:00 p.m. The following members were present: Jennifer Howell, Marci Dickson, Delores Hale, Jeremy Ball, Larry Morrow and Brian Harmon. Also present was Manager Sandy Pude.

1. Proposals for Curb Side Refuse Collection

Pude said that she contacted nine different refuse companies requesting proposals for a short term agreement for curb side collection.

Proposals were received from the following:

- Keystone Pick Up - \$18/per household – 96 gallon container limit
- Tri County Industries - \$30/per household – 96 gallon container limit

Pude said in the past the Borough has had contracts with Tri County Industries and they are an established company. Keystone Pick Up seems to be a newer company that did not have a DEP permit to collect over 10,000 pounds of municipal waste as of August 16th, but had made application for it.

Council discussed both proposals and although the cost would be cheaper with Keystone Pick Up, they were not sure about taking another chance with a newer company and possibly ending up in the same situation we are in now with the closing of Raccoon Refuse.

Larry Morrow made a motion to accept the proposal submitted by Tri County Industries for a short term agreement for the curb side collection of refuse. The motion was seconded by Jeremy Ball. A poll vote was taken:
