**Hearing of Citizens and Taxpayers**

**1. George & Travis Davis – 231 McClellan Street**

Travis Davis spoke to the Council about cars speeding on Snow Alley. He said some are going probably 35-40 miles an hour. He would like to see speed bumps installed to try and slow down the traffic.

Chief Acker said the Police Department can sit on Snow Alley to show a presence but they are unable to use timing devices because of the distance required. Also they can't cite anyone until they are 10 miles over the speed limit.

Hale said she didn't think that speed bumps would be feasible on Snow Alley.

Council decided to install a stop sign on Snow Alley at the intersection with Hicks Alley. The sign will have a flashing light on it. Pude will ask Attorney Shaddinger to draft an ordinance.

George Davis told Council that he is in the process of purchasing the Garver house at 229 McClellan Street. Once they have the closing on the property, he will apply for a demolition permit to have the house torn down.


